Program Fees

The Global Partners MBA program runs for 14 months from October to December of the following year. The program has a comprehensive fee structure that covers not only standard tuition and fees but many of the costs associated with an MBA program.

The program fee includes:

- All tuition and fees for the duration of the program across the 3 institutions
- All books and course materials including an I-pad
- The Washington, D.C. Module
 - o Roundtrip airfare to Washington, D.C., hotel accommodations, and transportation to and from airport and company visits
- The Brussels, Belgium Module
 - Train travel to Brussels from Paris, hotel accommodations, and transportation to and from company visits
- The Rio de Janeiro, Brazil Module
 - o Roundtrip airfare to Rio de Janeiro, transportation to/from airport and Ipanema, company visits, and transportation to/from school.
 - o Two group meals, coffee breaks/snacks during class sessions
- The Paris, France Module
 - o Airfare to Paris, France, transportation to/from airport to city center
- The China Module
 - o Airfare to China, inter-China flights, hotel accommodations for 2 weeks, transportation to/and from company visits, and cultural visits.
- The Atlanta, GA Modules
 - Access to the Buckhead Center facilities 24/7
 - o Coffee and Tea provided on a daily basis
 - Catered student and alumni events
- Assistance with visa processing for Brazil, France, and China (visa fees excluded)
- Graduation Application Fee and Graduation Reception

The program fee does not include:

- Housing in Atlanta, Rio de Janeiro, and Paris
- Personal expenses including meals
- Visas and insurance

Housing costs vary across locations due to individual preference and currency fluctuation. A housing budget of \$4,500 - 6,500 is recommended for the Paris and Rio de Janeiro portions of the program.

Program fee is \$72,000*
